



START-UP GUIDE



Victor® VLINK™ Mouse Trap Model: V450E | Victor® VLINK™ Rat Trap Model: V460E

WARNING: Electric Shock and Spark Hazards. **Ignition:** Do not use near unvented flammable vapors, liquids, or combustible solids. Do not use in barns, stables, or similar wet or dusty locations.

High Voltage: Keep out of reach of children and pets. Use only dry hands or rubber gloves to handle. Power OFF and bait. Do not touch metal plates when device is powered on.

BATTERIES: 4 AA Batteries are needed to operate this trap. Insert and remove batteries as indicated in the instructions. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the appliance before being charged. Different types of batteries or new and used are not to be mixed. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity as indicated in the battery compartment. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the trap and safely disposed of. If the trap is to be stored unused for a long period, the batteries should be removed. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

WARNING: An electric shock hazard may exist if water from a garden hose is directed at the rodent killer.

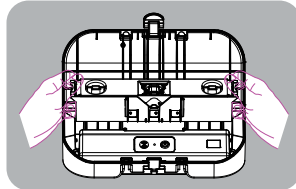

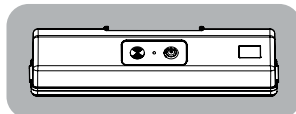
1. BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Open the outer case to access components.
When outer case lid is open, trap is disengaged.

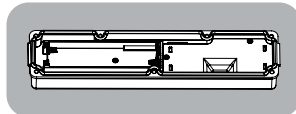
2. Remove the kill chamber.



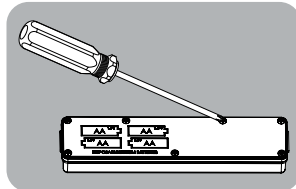
3. Slide out the power pak.



4. Open the battery compartment on the bottom side of the power pak and install the 4 “AA” lithium batteries (included).



5. Using a Philips head screw driver secure the battery compartment lid to the power pak with the 7 screws provided.



6. Reinstall the power pak.

7. Reinstall the kill chamber.

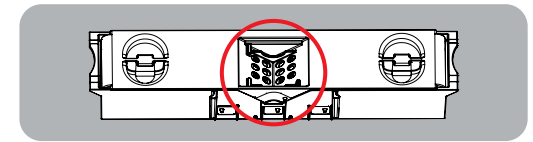
2. BAITING

Option A

1. Remove bait cup.
2. Place your preferred solid bait in the bait trough located on the top side of the kill chamber.
3. Replace bait cup.

Option B

1. Open bait cup and insert sticky or liquid bait into designated bait area.
2. Replace bait cup.



3. CONNECTING

1. Plug in the VLINK™ hub.

If you are planning to use your local network, plug your ethernet cable into the ethernet port.

4. DOWNLOAD THE APP

1. Download the VLINK™ app from the Apple or Google Play Store.



2. Launch the app and follow the on-screen instructions to connect your trap to the app.

5. SET TRAP

1. Once your trap has successfully connected, close the lid-and the trap is set!
2. Place traps indoors or outdoors.

After every 20-25 kills, thoroughly clean the metal plates inside the kill chamber with soapy water and a non-metallic brush, sponge, or scouring pad to maintain trap effectiveness. It is also recommended that the kill chamber be wiped down with a damp cloth after each kill to remove any debris.
